

Environmental Services Site Visit notes - Purposed Road upgrade – Reservoir St Chidlow

14 December 2023 and 14 February 2024



Photo 1: Two (2) Eucalyptus wandoo to be removed. No native vegetation underneath.

Photo 2: Another two (2) Eucalyptus wandoo to be removed. No native vegetation underneath. One of the trees has been heavily lopped with power lines overhead. Both have a DBH of approx. 50cm.



Photo 3: Small cluster of native vegetation on the eastern verge, measuring 36.90 sqm (0.0037 ha).



Photo 4: View of the eastern side of Reservoir Street that will be impacted for the purposed works to extend Reservoir St to Rosedale Road. The area measures 707sqm (0.0707ha) and includes -

A mix of native shrubs (banksia and tea tree sp), sedges, native grasses, 4 x Eucalyptus wandoo trees and some exotics (weeds).
